We visited 3 churches and 5 fellowships, about 20+ brothers, and sisters give to one-time mission fund. Several churches are considering to support us long-term. Praise the Lord.
- Abigail has turn three. Praise the Lord for taking care of her. Every night when we pray, she will want to pray first, although she probability doesn't understand that well, looking at her growth we are all very happy.
- Since we move, Caleb needs to change school. However, He would like to stay in the original school, so we must apply for transfer for him, sadly it was rejected at first. We appeal to the school district again, explain to them our situation, thank the Lord, they approve Caleb to "transfer" back to the original school, but only for one year. We thank God for providing for us and seeing Caleb's growth. He began to ask me some theological questions, I enjoy helping him going through some "theological inquiry" while we read the Bible, it was fun.
- We started to learn some Japanese, I have found a online learning program, with a reasonable price, thank God for the Internet. I function as a TA, to help Jennifer and Caleb learn some basic Japanese. Please pray for us, so we can have the perseverance to learn every day.
- Currently, I have at least one preaching invitation per month at a different church from July up to October. We are looking for more opportunities. If your church, fellowship or church that you know is interest in knowing more about the mission to Japan. Please help us connect, we would love to visit and share the spiritual need of Japan with your church. (I can preach in Mandarin or English, I can do short-talk in Taiwanese)
