
quite a bit of time reading an important mission history book, From Jerusalem to Irian Jaya by Ruth Tucker. In the past, I have read many missionary biographies, but this one is very unique. This book openly talked about the challenges, difficulties, weakness of missionaries, without any hesitation. Even the father of modern Protestant mission, William Carry, how he felt called to go to India, but his wife did not. Nevertheless, he dragged the whole family to India. His wife then suffers from a severe mental illness, no longer after that she dies, it was a tragedy. This book also talked about the marriage relationship struggle that Hudson Taylor had. Taylor almost drops out of the mission, because of a lady back home, not only that, he also suffered from loneliness and struggle greatly, due to cross-cultural and language learning. These negative examples did not mention very often in other biographies. However, these example trying to show us that missionaries are not super giant or very capable people. Missionaries simply are a group of weak people who obey God's calling and willing to follow God wherever He called. One significant difference I can see for missionaries was they all learn to hold-on to God because only Lord Jesus is everything to them.

These examples also tell us, how missionary family care ministry is so important. Missionaries are the soldier in front line, but if there is no logistical support, front line soldiers will die easily. It is very difficult to fight against the darkness of this world, especially those spiritual unreached countries. The amazing thing is, God is able to use weak people to accomplished His master plan. Only little over 200 years, the Protestant Christianity has spread from America/Europe to almost every part of the world. This witnessed the greatness of God. He calls the Christians and makes us the vessels of the gospel, in order to transform us in this process, so that we may receive His grace and the crown of glory in the future. This truly amazed me! God puts the needs of the people group in the heart of the missionaries. What missionaries need to learn is to obey God and relied on Him alone. We learn to share the love of Christ to a different people group and extend our hand to care for the spiritual need of the nations. The Lord puts Japan in our heart, would you pray with us, and care for this largest unreached people group in the developed nation in the world?

- September is the beginning of a new semester in Japan. There is a sad phenomenon during this time, which is a spike of teen suicide. Many students are bullied in school, going back to school feels like going back to hell. Parents or teachers may also become additional pressure when they force their kids to go back to school. Another major reason is student will face overwhelming academic competition, underperformance also is another major reason for suicide. 


Praise and Prayer:
