- 3. Why Japan? by YWAM Tokyo Every time I watch this video, I was moved to tear, because what he shares is exactly what I believe about Japan, I desire to see Japan become a major sending nation for the global mission work.
- 4. Reaching Youth in Japan by World Gospel Mission This video gives us some understanding of current state of Japanese churches, and why they still need many more foreign missionaries to help them expand God's kingdom in Japan.
- 5. Japan by David Robison Learn about Japan, this video briefly talks about Japan history, and also the spiritual need in Japan.
- 6. Missions as Fasting from Desiring God Michael Oh, the CEO of Lausanne Committee for World Evangelization also a missionary in Japan, preached at a Desiring God conference, which host by Pastor John Piper. This message will help you understand the need in Japan, also challenge you to devote yourself to global mission work.
- 7. The last video is only in Mandarin Chinese, it talks about how missionary raises support and what is involved.
